

GREATER HAMILTON USBC BOWLING ASSOCIATION HALL OF FAME

Purpose of Hall of Fame

To perpetuate the names of all members in the area served by the Greater Hamilton USBC Bowling Association who have displayed outstanding or extraordinary ability. This ability may have been through: bowling achievements in league and/or tournament competition, contributions made toward the steady advancement of the game through long and faithful service in the administration of various organizations, or any activity that has provided for the continued progress of the game of American ten pins. The Hall of Fame has been established to be a continuing monument to all those selected.

Qualifications – Hall of Fame

To qualify for nomination to the Hall of Fame, an individual must meet the following requirements: they must have participated in organized bowling in the Greater Hamilton USBC Bowling Association for a minimum of 10 years. They must display achievements in the area of bowling and have a reputation for sportsman-like conduct.

Qualifications – Lifetime Achievement

To qualify for nomination to the Hall of Fame for Lifetime Achievement, an individual must have participated in organized bowling in the Greater Hamilton USBC Bowling Association for a minimum of 10 years and demonstrate significant contributions to the general welfare of the game of bowling.

Nominations

Applications are available to any member of the Greater Hamilton USBC Bowling Association who may wish to nominate an individual for consideration to the Hall of Fame. The completed application should contain the name and qualifications of the nominee and may be submitted to any member of the Greater Hamilton USBC Bowling Association. Applications will be retained for consideration for three years. The application may be submitted again after the three-year period expires. **APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY FEBRUARY 28.** The Greater Hamilton USBC Bowling Association Hall of Fame Committee will review each application carefully prior to the vote. A nominee must receive 60% of all votes cast, with no more than three nominees elected per year. The Greater Hamilton USBC Bowling Association Board of Directors and all previously elected Hall of Fame members will vote for the nominees at a special meeting.
